# innovative housing solutions

In February we celebrated two families closing on their Habitat Kent homes. While every closing is special, these mark the beginning of new opportunities that will provide more affordable housing in Grand Rapids.

Satoya and Chantal and Modeste (pictured above) are the first families to move into our zero lot line homes that are possible because of a new zoning law in Grand Rapids called the Non-Condo Zero Lot Line Development. This change allows the development of more homes in a more timely fashion. Both are extremely important as economically buildable land is in short supply in our community.



This short video explains the new Non-Condo Zero Lot Line Development zoning rule, and how that impacts Habitat Kent's ability to develop more housing for families.

Because of this rule, two residential units can be built sharing a common wall, like a duplex, yet owned through separate deeds like a condominium, but without a homeowners association.

It will allow for low-complexity, higher density housing, without drastically changing the neighborhoods where they are developed. This is particularly exciting as Habitat Kent looks for ways to house more families in our community. To find out more about this new law, watch this short, informative video here.
